Before you begin

Apply early! Our first application deadline is January 30th, 2012, by this date we hope to select all our candidates for interviews. Only if we don't find suitable candidates, we will extend the application deadline to March 15, 2012.

We want to know you, and what you think of us. When answering your questions, be honest, tell us what you know, what you don't know, what makes you great and things you are working on. What matters most to us is who you are and what embarking on a Fellowship with Education Generation means to you. We want to understand what you like about our work, things you don't - be honest, be critical, be passionate.

Procedure. Please ensure your application form, short-answer responses and CV are properly labelled i.e. (firstname_lastname_CV). Please print, fill out pages 2 & 3 of this application, scan it, and e-mail it to us at info@educationgeneration.org We will get in touch to confirm we've received your application. Selected candidates will be called in for an interview on the week of March 17th.

Logistical Questions

Interviews. If you're selected for an interview you will be invited to Education Generation's offices in Vancouver. If you live outside Vancouver we will arrange a Skype call.

Fundraising. Before departure all Fellows are required to Fundraise a minimum of \$1,200. This is a great way to involve your network in your experience. We will provide you with fundraising pages on our website to support your fundraising.

Costs & Financial Assistance. Past Fellows have spent approximately \$3,500 (all inclusive) for a 6 week period. Unfortunately we are unable to provide financial assistance but are happy to support any fundraising efforts and act as your reference if applying for travel grants.

Field Placement. If you are selected to join the our Fellowship Program, you will take part in a 4-6 week placement with one of Education Generation's partners. Depending on your placement, you may live with a host family or in hostel-type accommodation. You will be hosted by our partner and work alongside scholarship recipients.
